General Information about the Republic of Indonesia



Geographical Location:

Indonesia is located in Southeast Asia and Oceania, consisting of a large archipelago between the Indian and Pacific Oceans. It shares land borders with Malaysia, Papua New Guinea, and Timor-Leste, and maritime borders with Singapore, the Philippines, and Australia. It is the world's largest archipelagic state by area.

Trade Relations between Saudi Arabia and Indonesia

Trade Exchange Volume between Saudi Arabia and Indonesia

May 2025

- **Exported** products worth SAR 1.1 billion to Indonesia, representing 1.2% of the Kingdom's total exports during that month.
- **Amounted** non-oil exports to SAR 199.4 million, with chemical industries and related products topping the list of goods exported to Indonesia.
- Topped the list of products exported to Indonesia were mineral fuels, oils, waxes, inorganic chemical products, and organic or inorganic compounds.
- **Imported** products worth SAR 901.6 million from Indonesia, representing 1.1% of the Kingdom's total imports during that month.
- **Topped the list** of products imported from Indonesia were vehicles (excluding railway or tramway) and parts, along with animal or vegetable fats, oils and waxes.
- **By the end of 2024**, Indonesia ranked 22nd in overall trade exchange volume with the Kingdom, 21st in exports, and 17th in imports.

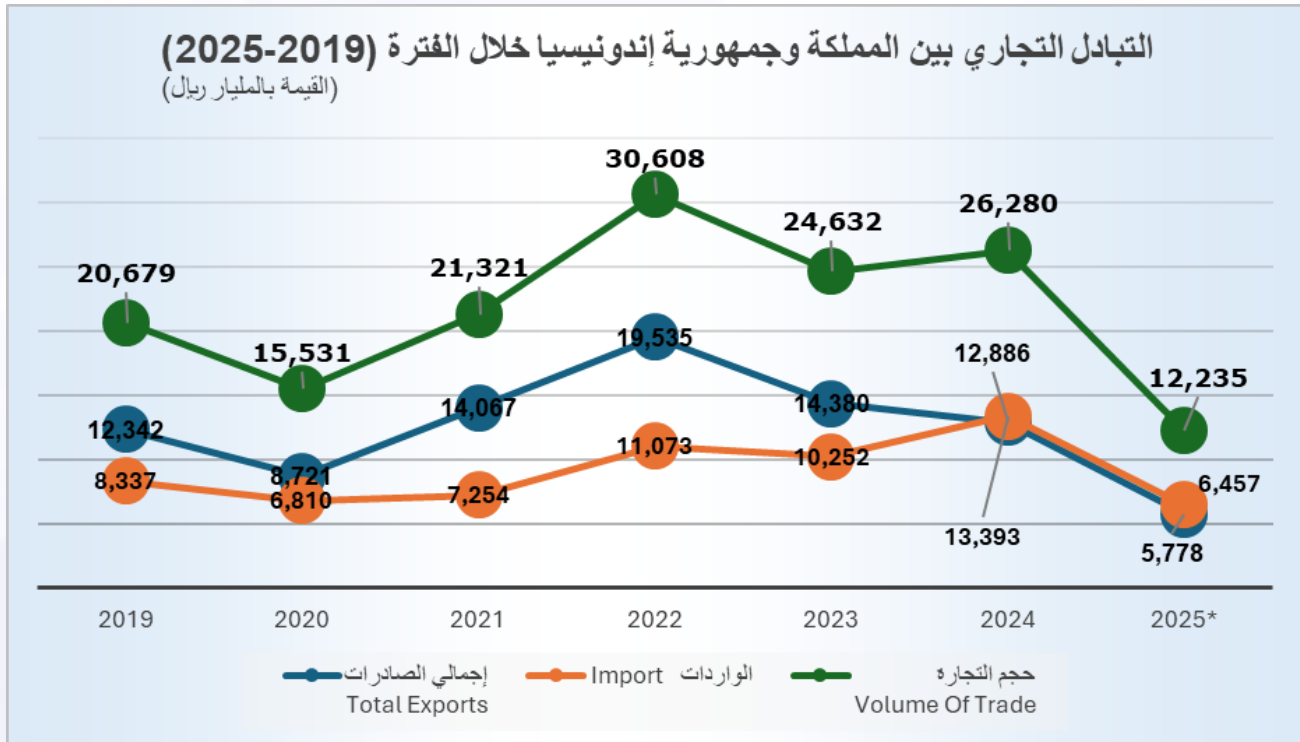

During 2019 – 2025 trade exchange between Saudi Arabia and Indonesia reached SAR 30.608 billion in 2022, marking the highest recorded value, while it declined to its lowest level of SAR 15.531 billion in 2020.
